

# Lynnville City Council Meeting Minutes

## April 14, 2015

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The City Council of the City of Lynnville met in regular session on April 14, 2015, at 5:30 p.m. at the City Hall in Lynnville, Iowa. Mayor Kelly Bryan welcomed those present to the meeting, called the meeting to order; and asked those present to stand, face the flag, and repeat the Pledge of Allegiance.
