

# Lynnville City Council Meeting Minutes

## October 9, 2017 – 5:30 p.m.

Council Members present: Roger Beason, Mark Newberg & Hugh Carney and Bev Van Maanen. Terry Fraker were absent.

**MEETING AGENDA:** Motion was made by Beason and seconded by Van Maanen, to approve the meeting agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

**MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** Newberg made motion to approve the minutes of September meeting, seconded by Beason, all ayes, Motion Carried.

**CITY CLAIMS AND PAYROLL:** Van Maanen made motion to pay all city claims, seconded by Beason, all ayes, motion Carried.

Faye Brand updated the council with information she obtained from Alliant Energy concerning electric hookups at Old Setts. 3 to 10 campsites were quoted around \$9000, would need to seek bids from electricians to run wire from pole to pedestals. She will discuss with Chamber to see if this would be a project they would like to work on. She also inquired if council had any objections to the chamber partnering with Val's Ventures for a Santa visit. Council had no objections.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Mayor James reported that he had spoken to 1 owner about the unlicensed vehicles, but it is still on the property. Mayor stated will also look into quotes for signs at cemetery by spring.

**TRUNK OR TREAT:** Carney made motion for Lynnville's trunk or treat to be held in conjunction with the pumpkin roll and the fireman's soup supper on Saturday October 28 from 5 to 7, Van Maanen seconded, all ayes, motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:** The Lynnville Library is looking for a new board member per Shirley Dunsbergen reported by City Clerk, Bev Arthur. City Clerk noted that many reservations are being made for Old Setts for next year and was inquiring if it should be mandatory for dram insurance if alcohol is on the property. Council stated to talk with city insurance agent before making contact with city lawyer. Mayor inquired about possibility of motion lights at the ball park to eliminate lights being left on, also encouraged anyone who might be thinking about running the concessions stand to seriously consider it as no one has expressed any interest yet.

**MAINTENANCE REPORT:** Josh Dewitt along with council discussed the possibility of putting in a new line from the city shed through to Fitzpatrick's since this seems to be the worst area problem and it could possibly save some money. Would need to get estimates, permits and Jack Pope was in agreement as well. Beason made motion for Dewitt to make the necessary

contacts with Jack Pope and to get estimates to replace the line from Jim Van Zante and Wes Van Wyk, Newberg seconded, all ayes, motion carried. Cement work has also been completed.
